On the other hand, Mongolia's population is predicted to grow almost 20% to 3,5 million by 2030. Therefore, GDP is projected to grow 6 times to 60 billion in 2030. Mongolia may be one of the fastest growing economies in the world if this scenario will be materialized.

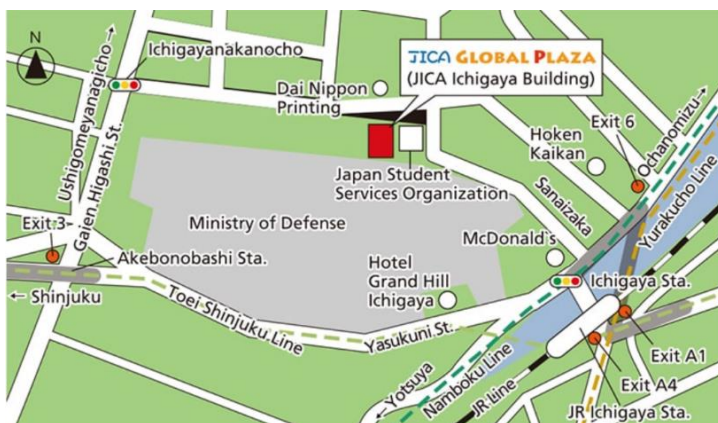
So, the questions will be.....
